Some examples from the over **5000 persons/families** that we have helped

### **Future Technology Leaders Receiving Assistance from CCCP/RSVP**

CCCP/RSVP created a computer lab for Peace Valley Haven in Hempstead for their after school STEM program that serves grades 1 to 9. To complete the installation WIFI adapters were supplied for the desktops to get on their WIFI network.

### **Helping Homeless Veterans**

CCCP provided 5 computers, a printer and internet connectivity to the Veteran's Place Shelter in Yaphank.

One such example is a recent desktop computer delivery in Rocky Point. The house of our client had a very steep driveway with at least a 45 degree slope. CCCP deliverer had to park a couple blocks away and was huffing and puffing when he reached the door. The client's family was very happy as the client is a child that is deaf. The family is Spanish and doesn't speak English.

### **Supporting a Boy Scout's Eagle Project**

CCCP supported a teenage member, who refurbishes computers and is a Boy Scout, in his Eagle Scout Project. He worked through his Church to have them provide a list of needy persons/families that needed a computer. He requested donations of old laptops from Church members. He collected and refurbished these laptops and provided fundamental training on how to use these laptops when providing them to the needy families.
